



# **Guidelines For Merging of IGNOAPS and RSBY Data**

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# GUIDELINES FOR MERGING OF IGNOAPS AND RSBY DATA

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## 1. Enrollment of all IGNOAPS eligible persons under RSBY

- 1.1 RSBY State Nodal Agency (SNA) in consultation with the nodal department for National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) shall finalise the RSBY list containing the IGNOAPS beneficiaries in addition to the RSBY beneficiaries.  
(All IGNOAPS beneficiaries, not previously on the RSBY list will also be covered with RSBY and all RSBY beneficiaries eligible for IGNOAPS will be automatically flagged for it based on pre-defined criteria.)
  - All BPL beneficiaries more than or equal to 60 will be flagged as IGNOAPS beneficiaries
  - The RSBY list already has flagging for BPL beneficiaries
- 1.2 The list will have the IGNOAPS beneficiaries flagged.
- 1.3 RSBY cards will be issued as per existing process of RSBY.
  - 1.3.1 The details available on the card in relation to the IGNOAPS beneficiaries would be as follows:
    - Unique Relationship number (for the family)
    - Member id (of IGNOAPS beneficiary)
    - Beneficiary Name
    - Date of Birth (and age)
    - BPL status
    - SC/ST/OBC status
- 1.4 Post enrollment data will be provided to designated department.

## 2. Process of merging IGNOAPS and RSBY data

- 2.1 The GP should have available 2 lists
  - List A with names and other details of all IGNOAPS eligible people in the GP. If possible they should also have the BPL number, Family ID, etc. available on this list
  - List B with details of all BPL families eligible for RSBY
- 2.2 The two lists are compared for the following
  - List A is compared to List B and all those IGNOAPS beneficiaries already available on the List B i.e. RSBY eligible beneficiaries are marked on both the lists.
  - All IGNOAPS beneficiaries on List A, not on List B (RSBY beneficiaries) should be added to List B.
    - Care should be taken to add them with the correct family id.
    - In case not already available, details of family members should also be added.
    - All beneficiaries eligible for IGNOAPS from List B (RSBY beneficiaries) should be added to List A.

2.3 The enhanced List B with IGNOAPS families added should be provided to the District officials for consolidation and submission to SNA.

Once this data merging is complete, the normal RSBY processes shall follow as per schedule in which the eligible households as per data provided by the State to the Insurance Company shall be covered under Health Insurance.

Care should be taken during IEC activities to spread proper awareness to the eligible beneficiaries.

Once the families have been enrolled, the data for those marked as IGNOAPS eligible persons would be provided to the designated authority at the district level in electronic form.
