Subject: COVID-19 Vaccination Session planning and vaccine utilization- regarding  
Sir/Madam,

In continuation to the already circulated MoM of State Steering Committee held  
on dated 27.05.2021, the following points are reiterated:-

1. Strategy for onsite/ online booking for tribal/Hard areas (Like Dodra Kwar) and  
non-tribal areas for 18-44 years vaccination shall be as follows:

**a. Tribal Areas/Hard areas**

- In tribal areas sessions may be planned for 100% on site registration and scheduling. In case such sessions are planned, prior intimation to the state must be given.
- As per the planning of the district, sessions may be planned for 100% online registration and scheduling as well. In case of left over slots due to absence of the pre scheduled beneficiary or extra doses in the vaccine vial, Onsite registration and scheduling mode may be used to minimize vaccine wastage subject to max 9 slots.

**b. Non Tribal and other than Hard Areas**

- Vaccination will be done only after the online scheduling and appointments. Sessions will be published as per the guidelines. i.e. two days prior to the vaccination day between 2.30-3.00 P.M. In case of left over slots due to absence of the pre scheduled beneficiary or extra doses in the vaccine vial, session may be extended online subject to maximum of 9 slots. **New vial would not be opened.**

The District Administration/ local Administration must be involved in the planning of onsite sessions in tribal/hard areas to ensure no overcrowding/law and order situation arises.

2. In the 18-44 years age group for the 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2021 sessions, districts can plan sessions by increasing number of sessions before publishing as per availability of vaccines allocated for the month of May, 2021. Extending the capacity of sessions is not encouraged, however may be done if a full session of 100 beneficiaries is not possible due to lesser amount of vaccine availability.

3. All Districts should monitor the vaccine wastage diligently and ensure that it should not be more than zero percent.

It is requested that the sessions may be planned accordingly.
