

PROGRAMME STRATEGY

- Active surveillance: Monthly house visit by the MPW (Male & Female) and collect the Blood smear 1% of population.
- Passive surveillance: All fever cases attending OPD must be advised blood smear examined for Malaria in all institutions 15% of OPD.
- DDT spray operation not being done in the State as API less than 2 and above during any of the preceding 3 years.

TREATMENT:

- Radical treatment to all Malaria positive cases within 10 days of detection.
- Severe and complicated cases of Malaria are treated at nearest referral Centre.

IEC ACTIVITIES:

- Increase awareness about Malaria.
- Motivate community to adopt preventive measures for vector control.
- Aware about personal protection from mosquito by using repellants and mosquito nets.

VECTOR CONTROL STRATEGY:

- Cover stored water, drain system and maintain them by regular training disinfecting and avoiding stagnation of water.
- Coolers, old tyres, flower pots and other places where water may collect become breeding place for mosquitoes.
- Observe weekly dry days for all such potential breeding spots.
